



FAR SOUTH COAST VETERAN'S WEEK OF GOLF

2025 Conditions of Entry & Play.

ELIGABILITY. As per the NSWVGA requirements, to be eligible to compete in events under the guidance of NSWVGA, players [Men and Ladies] must be current financial members of NSWVGA and be 55 years or over at the start of the tournament. Non-financial members can join NSWVGA at registration or on arrival at our tournament by payment of the \$5 affiliation fee. This fee entitles a member to play in any NSWVGA event for the calendar year.

FORMAT: The tournament will be played over 36 holes (Stableford) with 18 holes on the Thursday & Friday. **All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited, together with such Local Rules as are in force on the course over which the competitions take place.**

Players must hold a current GA handicap and be members of a recognised golf club. Maximum Handicaps will be 36 for Men & 45 for Ladies. Players with handicaps higher than the published limit, may be accepted to play, although they will play off the maximum handicaps of the competition. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps during the competition. Divisions & grades will be determined after entries close.

TROPHIES: In accordance with NSWVGA guidelines, there will be daily prizes, NTP's and ball rundown. No player may win more than one Major trophy during the event EXCEPT for the NSW Veteran Golfers Assoc Trophies. The NSWVGA donate trophies annually. These Trophies – are awarded to the men's and women's winner of the Friday 18-hole event. Tied scores: Winners will be decided on countback. Any decisions made by the Tournament Committee will be final.

Presentation of trophies for all events & NSWVGA Shield will be held at Presentation Lunch Friday. Daily ball rundowns & novelty prizes may be presented daily.

Entries close 1st July 2025. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Directors. Refunds: - There will be a \$30 admin fee for refunds made after entries have closed.
