



# **2026 Ace of Clubs**

## **Conditions of Entry & Play- 2026**

By completing and submitting an entry form, each player agrees to the following conditions of play.

- An entry form must be completed for each player and entry fees to be paid before acceptance of entry. Competitors must state their name, Golf Link number, contact number and D.O.B
- Entry fees will be refunded for withdrawals before the draw is done and may be refunded after the draw in exceptional circumstances. A \$30 administration fee may be charged for any refunds.
- For all events (Sunday to Friday) eligible players are male and female amateurs holding a current Australian GA handicap. The Men's handicap limit is 36 and the Ladies handicap limit is 45.
- The Tournament Committee will control all competitions, which will be run in accordance with the Rules of Golf (R&A), and the local rules of the relevant clubs. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter the conditions for any event as may be deemed to be necessary. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decisions shall be final.
- Daily prizes are determined according to handicaps each playing day.
- Prizes (vouchers that can be used at any of the participating golf courses) are awarded at the discretion of the Tournament Committee and will be based on the number of entries and grades. A player who may otherwise be eligible for more than one prize will be awarded the prize with the highest value.
- Players must promptly return their score card to the match desk.
- In the event of a wash out of any round the Tournament Committee will determine the rounds which will decide the King and Queen of Clubs.
- For shotgun starts, competitors must register at the Pro Shop at least 30 minutes prior to the official start time.
- Score cards are required to be used at all clubs as they might be required for the countback situation.
- Participants are required to always adhere to dress regulations of the relevant club.
- Motorised transport may be used and is available for hire from the Pro shops. Hire of golf carts are at the responsibility of the player. It is recommended that carts be booked in advance. Please note that golf clubs might charge a cart fee for private golf carts.
- Electronic measurement devices are permitted to be used for measuring distance only.
- The Tournament Committee accepts no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the event including the participant's travel. Players entering this event do so at their own risk.
- TBCC social membership is included in the entry fee. A \$10 credit is charged to your membership and can be used at the Bar, Bistro or Proshop at Tura Beach CC.
- The Sunday Ambrose event is a bonus event and is included in the entry fee. This event is a stand alone event and the score is not used towards the winner of the King or Queen of Clubs. Vouchers will be issued and can be used at any of the competing golf courses.
- Friday lunch is included in the entry fee. Lunch orders will be taken at Registration or at the players first golf course played.
- Players may opt to pay \$70/day for the daily competition only. Players are requested to nominate which days they are playing otherwise it will be assumed that players will be playing on all 5 golf days.
- Participants need to be aware that these conditions are subject to change at short notice.

## **Countback Procedure to be used in the event of a tie for Overall 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place**

The player with the highest aggregate stableford score from the four courses will be declared the winner (King) male and (Queen) female event.

In the event of a tie for any of the first 3 places the following procedure will be applied

- i) The winner will be the golfer with the highest aggregate stableford points from the last nine (9) holes of each course or acceptable completed rounds
- ii) If the scores are equal, the points of the last six (6) holes, then the last three (3) holes from each course or acceptable completed rounds
- iii) If still equal then the points from each course for each hole counting back from the 18<sup>th</sup> hole will decide the places.
