## Conditions of Entry & Play- 2026

By completing and submitting an entry form, each player agrees to the following conditions of play.

- An entry form must be completed for each player and entry fees to be paid before acceptance of entry. Competitors must state the name of their home club, and Golf ID number.
- Entry fees will be refunded for withdrawals before the draw is done and may be refunded after the draw in medical or exceptional circumstances. A \$30 administration fee may be charged for any refunds.
- For all events (Sunday to Friday) eligible players are male and female amateurs holding a current Australian GA handicap. The Men's handicap limit is 36 and the Ladies handicap limit is 45.
- The Tournament Committee will control all competitions, which will be run in accordance with the Rules of Golf (R&A), and the local rules of the relevant clubs. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter the conditions for any event as may be deemed to be necessary. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decisions shall be final.
- The Tournament Committee shall have the right to alter a player's handicap during the Tournament and may vary the handicap limits for the 54 - hole event. Daily prizes are determined according to handicaps each playing day.
- Prizes are awarded at the discretion of the Tournament Committee and will be based on the number of entries and grades. A player who may otherwise be eligible for more than one prize will be awarded the prize with the highest value.
- Players must promptly either return their score card to the match desk or submit their score via phone.
- All our events are shotgun starts, competitors must register at the Pro Shop at least 30 minutes prior to the official start time.
- Mobile phones are not permitted to be used on the golf course during tournament play except in the following circumstances:
  - to facilitate using the MiScore App
  - in a medical emergency
  - to contact the Pro Shop on a golf related matter
- Participants are required to always adhere to dress regulations of the relevant club.
- Motorised transport may be used and is available for hire from the Pro shops. It is recommended that carts be booked well in advance. There may be a charge for people using their own carts on some courses.
- Electronic measurement devices are permitted to be used for measuring distance only.
- If the playing conditions are deemed dangerous (e.g., lightning) or unplayable (e.g., severe weather) a member of the Tournament Committee or the Pro shop may suspend play. Suspension of play will be advised by one long blast from a siren at the clubhouse. On hearing this siren, all players MUST suspend play by marking their ball and returning to the clubhouse. Players are not to resume play until advised by two short sirens repeated or verbally advised by a Tournament Committee member.
- The Tournament Committee accepts no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the event including the participant's travel. Players entering this event do so at their own risk.
- Participants need to be aware that these conditions are subject to change at short notice.
