Conditions of Play

1. All events are open to amateur women members of any Golf Australia affiliated club with GA handicap. The maximum daily playing handicap cannot exceed 45. Players with larger handicaps are welcome to play but must play off 45.
2. Field limit of 120 players. In the event of more than 120 entries being received, priority will be given to players registered under the Play Together Package followed by Play Harder Package and thereafter Play Smarter Package.
3. The Tura Beach Ladies Golf Club Match Committee (the Match Committee) reserves the right to alter or make variations to the Event, if deemed necessary. The handicap limits for each Division will be based on GA Handicap Division 1: (0 – 20), Division 2: (20.1 – 29), Division 3 (29.1- 45).
4. A tie in Event 1: Open Scratch will be decided by a sudden death play-off on holes nominated by the Match Committee; all other ties will be decided by a GA countback.
5. No player may receive more than one trophy, with the exception of the Challenge Salver and novelty Events 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11.
6. All Golf ID Numbers and handicaps will be confirmed at the Player Registration. Players will compete on their current handicap applicable on the day of the tournament.
7. The Match Committee shall settle any dispute on the day of play and their decision shall be final.
8. In the event of a player being unable to compete, a substitute may be entered in her place upon notice. In general no monies will be refunded after the Draw is completed. For cancellations and substitutions an administration fee will be charged. Please notify by email to golf@turabeachcountryclub.com.au or phoning the Pro Shop 02 6495 9068.
9. Golf Carts - The use of Golf Carts is permitted for all players. Players must make their own arrangements to reserve a cart by contacting the Pro Shop (02) 6495 9068.
10. By participating, players consent to the use of their images for promotional purposes.
11. Event 4: Challenge Salver
 - a. Teams consist of 4 players from the same Club and limited to 3 teams per Club. The best 3 nett scores will be used. Players to be nominated in one team only.
 - b. The winning Team will be the best aggregate nett score.
 - c. The Club Name of the winning team will be engraved on the Challenge Salver and each Team member will receive an award.
 - d. Ties will be decided by countback using the best score card of the three team members. If still tied, then the next best card will be used.
12. Event 8: Nearest the Pin Division 1- 9th hole, Division 2 – 3rd hole, Division 3rd hole, Division 3 – 5th Hole (second shot).
13. Event 10: Hole In One
 - a. The event applies only on Hole 3 at Tura Beach Golf Club from the red markers.
 - b. A hole-in-one will only be deemed valid if the ball comes to rest completely within the hole and must be verified by the players card marker.
 - c. The \$1000 prize will be awarded to the first player to record a verified hole-in-one. Once the prize has been won, the competition will cease immediately. Division 2 Players may continue to compete for nearest-the-pin prizes.
 - d. The prize is not transferrable to another person.
14. Event 11: Team of three – a player selects a team of three players from the competition and must include themselves as one of the 3 team members. The best nett aggregate score wins.

Conditions of Play for Hole in One Shoot Out.

Friday 11th September 2026 From 4pm.

1. ELIGIBILITY

- **Registered participants:** Only players officially registered in the Tura Beach ladies Open 2026 on September 12th - 13th 2026 are eligible. Players who have purchased a Play Together or a Play Harder package will receive one complimentary entry. These players, and all other registered participants may purchase 2 balls for \$5.00.
- **Amateur Status:** Participation is restricted to amateur golfers as defined by Golf Australia. Professional golfers are not eligible.
- **Handicap:** Entrants must hold an official Golf ID Number.

2. COMPETITION RULES

- **Hole:** The competition applies only on Hole 9 at Tura Beach Golf Club from the yellow markers.
- **No Practice:** Practice shots on the prize hole strictly prohibited.
- **Designated Equipment:** Players must use personal equipment meeting R&A/USGA Rules. Golf balls will be provided for those not wishing to use their own.

3. VERIFICATION AND ADJUDICATION

- **Independent Witness:** All attempts must be witnessed by a designated tournament official
- **Official confirmation:** A hole-in-one will only be deemed valid if the ball comes to rest completely within the hole.

4. PRIZE INFORMATION

- **First Achiever Only:** The \$2000 prize will be awarded to the first player to record a verified hole-in-one. Once the prize has been won, the competition will cease immediately. Players may continue to compete for nearest-the-pin prizes.
- **Non-Transferrable:** The prize is not transferrable to another person.

5. LIABILITY AND GENERAL

- **Weather Cancellations:** The organisers reserve the right to cancel or modify the competition due to safety concerns or inclement weather.
- **Safety:** Participants are responsible for their own safety and well being during the event. The organisers will accept no liability for any injuries, damages or losses incurred during the event.
- **Publicity:** By participating, players consent to the use of their images and /or video footage for promotional purposes.
- **Decision final:** All decisions made by tournament committee are final and binding.
