



FAR SOUTH COAST VETERAN'S WEEK OF GOLF



2027 Conditions of Entry & Play.

ELIGIBILITY. As per the NSWVGA requirements, to be eligible to compete in veteran inter-club events & NSWVGA weeks of golf under the guidance of NSWVGA, players [Men and Ladies] must be current financial members of NSWVGA. Non-financial members can join NSWVGA at registration or on arrival at our tournament by payment of the \$5 affiliation fee for the calendar year.

Male and Female players must:

- (a) Have attained the age of 55 years as of the first day of the tournament.
- (b) Hold current membership of a registered Golf Club. (as per the Constitution.)
- (c) Hold a current Golf Australia handicap.
- (d) Be a financial member of the NSW Veterans Golf Association

FORMAT: The week of golf will be played with a 4BBB on the Monday, Individual Stableford Tuesday & championship over 36 holes (Stableford) with 18 holes each on the Thursday & Friday. **All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited, together with such Local Rules as are in force on the course over which the competitions take place.**

Players must hold a current Golf ID handicap and be members of a recognised golf club. Maximum Handicaps will be 36 for Men & 45 for Ladies. Players with handicaps higher than the published limit, may be accepted to play, although they will play off the maximum handicaps of the competition. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps during the competition. Divisions & grades will be determined after entries close. Players will play off their Golf ID Daily handicap. Scores will be processed each day.

TROPHIES: In accordance with NSWVGA guidelines, there will be daily prizes, NTP's and ball rundown. No player may win more than one Major trophy during the event EXCEPT for the annually donated NSWVGA Trophies. The small NSWVGA shields – are awarded to the men's and women's winner of the Thursday 18-hole event. The large NSWVGA shields are awarded to the best 36-hole score for Men & Ladies irrespective of grades. Tied scores: Winners will be decided on countback. Any decisions made by the Tournament Committee will be final. **Presentation of trophies for all events & NSWVGA Shields will be held at Presentation Lunch Friday. Daily ball rundowns & novelty prizes may be presented daily.**

Entries close Friday 29th January 2027. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Directors. Entry fee includes Presentation lunch.

Refunds: - Entry fees will be refunded for withdrawals before the draw is done and may be refunded after the draw in exceptional circumstances. A \$30 administrative fee may be charged for any refunds • Refunds will be applicable if no play is allowed due to inclement weather conditions.

GOLF CARTS: ▪ Please advise if you require a cart or if you are bringing your own cart or ride-on. For those requiring a cart, or to use their own cart the cost will be advised by the pro-shop at each course. Payment will be on the day.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: • Players can play in the weekend club competitions only paying a competition fee, alternatively players can play social golf on the weekend after the competition dates without paying green fees. Tura Beach Country club accepts no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the event including the participant's travel.
